Safety Policy of the Rio Texas Conference of the UMC

According to the Safety Policy of the Rio Texas Conference of the United Methodist Church, all clergy, staff and volunteers who work with children, youth and vulnerable adults must complete a background check and attend training to become Safety Certified as a "Trusted" adult through the Rio Texas Conference. This includes Sunday school teachers and substitutes, FISH volunteers, VBS volunteers, youth sponsors at youth group and mission trips, chaperones for lock-ins, drivers, etc. This certification lasts for 2 years. Events that do not have at least 2 Safety Certified adults present, and maintain a 1:8 certified adult/child ratio will have to be canceled.
